### **Integrated Service Delivery Model**

Horizon is an advocate for partnerships that enhance the care provided to New Brunswickers. For children, youth and families, the Integrated Service Delivery (ISD) Model provides a more collaborative support system for children with emotional, behavioural, mental health or addiction needs.

The model is supported by four government departments: Health (Addictions and Mental Health); Education; Social Development; and, Justice and Public Safety. Child and Youth (CY) ISD teams work with professionals across departments to ensure children and youth receive the right service, at the right time, with the right intensity. Horizon's Addiction and Mental Health Services provides oversight to the community-based ISD CY teams.

ISD has already demonstrated that through collaboration, we can enhance child and youth development, provide timely and accessible care, be more efficient through planning and coordination, and use resources more effectively. These are the partnerships we are proud of.
